(Dangerous Goods and Special Load Manual – Chapter 2)

Passenger: Members of the New Zealand Cinematographers Society Inc.

(when requested, membership identification must be produced)

Approved to Carry: Spare Batteries – up to 58 (includes lithium ion not exceeding 100Wh, non-

spillable up to 12V and 100Wh and dry cell batteries)

Spare Lithium Ion Batteries - up to 2 exceeding 100Wh but not exceeding

160Wh

Lithium Ion Battery – exceeding 100Wh but not exceeding 160Wh contained

in a device

Effective: 1st January 2024 to 31st December 2024

This document permits carriage of the above passenger's batteries and lithium battery powered device on Air New Zealand, provided the following carriage requirements have been met:

Spare Batteries - Carriage Requirements

- all battery terminals mut be protected e.g. retail packaging, taped, speciality container etc.
- no more than 60 batteries (in total) per person
- carried in carry-on baggage only

Lithium Ion Battery in a Device - Carriage Requirements

- battery does not exceed 160Wh
- carried in carry-on baggage or if in checked bags, must be:
 - turned off e.g. not in sleep mode and can't be accidentally turned on
 - protected from damage
